One Day Multi-Disciplinary National Conference On Literature, Science & Society: New Directions of Development

A one-day National Conference was organized on Tuesday, 18th February 2025 by the Humanities Departments in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), at the Seminar Hall of National Senior College, Nashik. The conference began at 10:00 am with the registration of participants, followed by a grand inaugural function.

Mr. Shaikh Sohail Umar (Voice President YEWS) chaired the inaugural session, The dignitaries present on the dais included Prof. Zahid A. Shaikh (Secretary, YEWS), Mr. Gause Ala Noor (Treasurer, YEWS), and Mr. Saleem Sayyed (Management Member, YEWS). The event began with the recitation of the Holy Quran by SYBA student Gulam Gause, followed by a soulful rendition of Naat-e-Paak by FYBCOM student Shaikh Masroofa.

The Presidential motion and welcome note were proposed by Dr. Suresh Nahire, Principal of the college, who warmly welcomed the guests and participants. Dr. Suhasini Jadhav (English Department) presented the aims and objectives of the conference. The official journal of the seminar, comprising Thirty-Five research papers, was released during the function.

Prof. Zahid Shaikh delivered an insightful talk on contemporary educational and social trends, while Mr. Shaikh Sohail Umar, in his presidential address, appreciated the literary spirit of the seminar and emphasized the need to bridge the gap between science, literature, and society. The session concluded with a formal vote of thanks by the Asst. Prof. Noor Mohammed.

Technical Session I:

Chairperson: Dr. Samiuddin

(A.R.S. Inamdar Arts, Science and Commerce College, Vijayapur, Karnataka)

The keynote address by Dr. Majeed Bedar (Hyderabad), who presented a thought-provoking discourse on the multidimensional role of literature in shaping social consciousness. He emphasized how literature, across ages and cultures, has served not only as a mirror reflecting the socio-political realities of its time but also as a transformative force inspiring collective awareness and change. Dr. Bedar illustrated this with references to classical as well as modern works, underlining how the written word continues to influence public opinion, awaken moral responsibility, and nurture critical thought in society.

Following this, Dr. Yusuf Sabir (Associate Professor, J.J.T University, Jhunjhunu, Rajasthan) presented an insightful paper focusing on the literary dynamics in post-independence India. His presentation traced the evolution of literary trends after 1947, highlighting how writers responded to issues of identity, nation-building, and socio-cultural transformation in a newly independent nation. Dr. Sabir also examined the emergence of fresh voices, experimental styles, and thematic shifts that characterized this era, emphasizing the vital connection between literature and the changing aspirations of Indian society.

Technical Session II:

Chairperson: Dr. Gause Ahmed Nabilal Shaikh
(Chairman, Board of Studies Urdu, Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University)

The second session began at 2:10 pm. Speakers included:

The second technical session of the conference commenced at 2:10 p.m. under the chairmanship of Dr. Gause Ahmed Nabilal Shaikh, a distinguished academician and Chairman of the Board of Studies in Urdu & Persian at Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University.

This session brought together eminent scholars and researchers, each contributing valuable perspectives aligned with the overarching theme of the conference — “Literature, Science & Society: New Directions of Development.”

Dr. Samiuddin (Bijapur) presented a scholarly paper that examined the intersections of literature and cultural identity, emphasizing how contemporary narratives serve as a bridge between traditional values and modern social realities.

Mr. Ravindra Aadhav (National Senior College, Nashik) shared his insights on the role of scientific temper and rational inquiry in literature, highlighting the transformative impact of science on modern thought and literary expression.

Mr. Athar Ali Asadi (80 Islamic Society, Chicago) offered an international perspective, focusing on the global resonance of literature in shaping diasporic identity, fostering intercultural dialogue, and addressing issues of belonging and societal development.

The session was marked by lively discussions, thought-provoking questions, and interactive exchanges between the presenters and the audience, reflecting the multidisciplinary spirit of the conference.

Technical Session III:

Chairperson: Dr. Suhasini Jadhav
(Assistant Professor, National Senior College, Nashik)

Under the guidance of Dr. Suhasini Jadhav, the third technical session continued the conference's multidimensional exploration of how humanities and sciences interact to shape society.

Mr. Akshay Bhalekar examined the economic and political legacy of Dadabhai Naoroji, celebrated as the "Grand Old Man of India" and the first Asian member of the British Parliament. Bhalekar highlighted Naoroji's "Drain Theory," which argued that colonial policies siphoned wealth from India to Britain and became a rallying point for economic nationalism. He traced how Naoroji's advocacy for Indian control over economic resources influenced subsequent nationalist leaders and laid intellectual foundations for India's independence movement. By situating Naoroji's ideas within contemporary debates on decolonizing knowledge, the paper showed their enduring relevance in discussions of development and self-reliance.

Mrs. Saima Ansari introduced participants to the fundamentals of blockchain—a decentralized ledger technology—and explained how its features of immutability, transparency and security are transforming various sectors. Her presentation outlined the technology's potential uses in finance (cryptocurrencies and secure transactions), supply chains (verifiable provenance), healthcare (secure patient records), education (tamper-proof certification) and government services (transparent public records). Mrs. Ansari also discussed challenges such as scalability, energy consumption and regulatory uncertainty, urging academics to engage with technologists so that ethical considerations guide the adoption of blockchain.

Mrs. Naziya Miswal Khan's paper took a literary lens, analyzing Robert Frost's poem "Mending Wall" (1914). She noted that Frost is renowned for his realistic portrayal of rural life and that the poem functions as a dramatic monologue depicting the poet's annual ritual of rebuilding a stone wall with his neighbor. Khan emphasized that the poem critiques unnecessary barriers—"God doesn't like walls," as Frost suggests through images of frozen ground thawing and stones tumbling—yet also acknowledges the neighbor's insistence that "Good fences make good neighbors," reflecting the human desire for privacy and order. Drawing from Frost's use of absurdism to question social divisions, she argued that while boundaries can protect personal space and national sovereignty, unjust walls alienate communities. Khan urged the audience to cultivate empathy and dismantle metaphorical walls that divide society, thus aligning literature's insights with the conference's theme of development rooted in social consciousness.

The session concluded with engaging Q&A. Participants discussed how historical economic critiques, emerging digital technologies and poetic metaphors jointly inform new directions of development. Dr. Jadhav summarized that Mr. Bhalekar's historical analysis underscored the importance of economic self-determination; Mrs. Ansari's exploration of block chain demonstrated the transformative power of technology; and Mrs. Khan's literary interpretation reminded attendees that ethical and humanistic perspectives must accompany scientific progress. The session reinforced the conference's call for multidisciplinary collaboration to address contemporary challenges and foster a society that is both technologically advanced and deeply human.

Poster & Oral Presentations:

The final academic engagement of the conference day, held from 3:45 p.m. to 4:45 p.m., comprised Poster Presentations in the Geography Department and Oral Presentations in the Seminar Hall. These parallel sessions created an energetic academic environment where both faculty and students enthusiastically presented their research findings.

In the Poster Session, participants showcased visually rich and well-structured research works across multiple disciplines, ranging from literature and social sciences to cutting-edge developments in science and technology. The posters not only highlighted innovative ideas but also encouraged one-to-one interaction, enabling young researchers to receive constructive feedback from peers and senior academicians.

Simultaneously, the Oral Presentations provided a platform for scholars to communicate their research arguments in detail. Speakers presented papers covering diverse aspects of the conference theme — from critical literary analyses to explorations in applied sciences and societal studies. Each presentation reflected the central idea of the conference: how literature and science can work together to guide society toward inclusive and sustainable development.

The interactive nature of both sessions allowed for fruitful dialogue, as participants engaged in lively discussions, raised insightful questions, and shared multidisciplinary perspectives. This not only enhanced the intellectual richness of the event but also fostered a spirit of academic collaboration.

Overall, the Poster and Oral Presentation sessions exemplified the multidisciplinary ethos of the conference. They provided a vibrant forum for emerging voices in academia and ensured that the conference's objective — to explore new directions of development through literature, science, and society — was realized in practice

Their words further underlined the importance of blending literary and scientific insights for the holistic progress of society.

smooth and successful conduct of the event. Dr. Nahire highlighted the significance of collaborative learning and assured continued support for similar academic initiatives that promote inclusivity, innovation, and cultural values.
